Local Brass Band giving local concerts and general musical entertainment to the local community. We give an opportunity for likeminded brass instrumental musicians to play in a brass band.

We would like the grant to support our band at the local Princes Theatre. The cost of the hire of the theatre has risen considerably and without the income the band has enjoyed in previous years the band would struggle to survive. The cost of performing at the Princess has risen by about £300 per concert and we would like to request this cash difference in a Council Grant. We are requesting a total of £900 to cover the 3 concerts, that is Xmas 2021, Spring 2022 and Summer 2022.

Who will benefit from the project? The band is open to all regardless of any age or condition of disabilities.

How many people from Burnham-on-Sea and Highbridge will directly benefit from your project: The whole community can benefit from the band if they wish to participate either as a member or part of an audience.

How will they benefit: Everyone benefits from music if they care to participate.
